General Guidelines for Mahaprasadam Cooking Sponsors

Thank you for sponsoring (cooking) Thursday Maha Prasadam. We will the prasadam prepared for about 450-500 Devotees. Temple will provide all the cooking utensils required and there will be volunteers to help you with the cooking. You can also bring your family and friends to volunteer. This document has been developed with the hope of providing you with a general idea of what to expect and what you would need for the cooking.

- Prasadam cooking will start @ 5:00PM. (If you want to start before 5:00PM, please let us know)
- Prasadam will be served soon after Dhoop aarthi .
- Until 8:30 PM we will be serving prasadam in small boxes. After Shej Aarthi starts, we will serve the Mahaprasadam in big boxes (with three compartments).
- We have to prepare three items for the Mahaprasadam:
 - Rice Item (Pulihora / Vegetable Rice, Kichidi , etc...)
 - Curd Rice
 - Sweet

Required Items (For Pulihora, curd Rice, Kesari Sweet)

Rice (Basmati /Sona masoori) (20 LB Bags)	: 4
Jasmine Rice Bag (For Curd Rice)	: 1
Milk	: 5 Gallon
Oil Cans	: 2 Gallon
Ghee	: 1 Bottle
Green Chilli	: 2 LB
Red Chilli	: 1 Pack
Lemon Juice / Tamarind paste (For Pulihora)	: 8 Bottles
Curry leaves	: 3 Paks
Coriander Leaves	: 3 Bunches
Chana Dal	: 1 Big Pack
Urad Dal	: 1 Big Pack
Jeera	: 1 Big Pack
Mustard	: 1 LB
Cashews	: 1 Pack
Peanuts	: 1 Pack
Raisins	: 1 Pack
Sooji (For Kesari)	: 4 Packs (4lb packet)

If you want to prepare vegetable rice (No need Lemon / Tamarind Paste)

Mixed Vegetables	: 4 Big Packets
Pulav Masala mix	: 5 Packets
Garam Masala	: 1 Pack
